


CACHE HIKERS



2023 Winter Outings

31 December, 2023, Snowshoe (or boot) on the Bonneville Shoreline Trail The Cache Hikers will host a winter trip on the Bonneville Shoreline Trail on Saturday, (New Year's Eve Day). This is an easy/moderate snowshoe or boot hike, about 4 miles round trip and 300 feet of elevation. The route follows the "Deer Fence" north from Blacksmith Fork. This is the last opportunity to see (and hear?) coyotes at the nearby predator research facility before the trail is closed for the winter. Bring food, water, and extra clothing. Make sure your equipment is adequate and you have the skill and stamina necessary for the trip. The trip leader may alter plans if necessary.

Meet at 10:00 a.m. at the southwest corner of the Smith's Marketplace parking lot, 750 North Main Street, with an expected return about 1:00 p.m.

19 February, 2023, Ski/Snowshoe at Long Hollow The Cache Hikers will host a winter trip to Long Hollow on Sunday. This is a moderately strenuous cross-country ski or snowshoe activity, about 4 miles with 1200 feet of elevation gain, beginning at the Sink Hollow Winter Trailhead and heading northwest up the ridge adjacent to Long Hollow. Bring food, water and extra clothing. Make sure your equipment is adequate and that you have the skill and stamina necessary for the trip. The trip leader may alter plans if necessary.

26 February, 2023 Ski/Snowshoe at White Pine Ridge The Cache Hikers will host a winter trip to White Pine Ridge on Sunday. This is a moderately strenuous cross-country ski or snowshoe activity, about 5 miles with 1200 feet of elevation gain. The route climbs southwest as we explore terrain above White Pine Creek, with views of upper Logan Canyon and lower White Pine creek. Bring food, water, and extra clothing. Make sure your equipment is adequate and that you have the skill and stamina necessary for the trip. The trip leader may alter plans if necessary.

This is an easy snowshoe or moderate cross-country ski activity to a view point overlooking Cache Valley, about 3 miles round trip with 500 feet of elevation. Bring a headlamp/flashlight, warm drink, and warm clothing. Make sure your equipment is adequate and that you have the skill and stamina necessary for the trip. The trip leader may alter plans if necessary.
