

30 December, 2023, Snowshoe on Blacksmith Fork River Trail

The Cache Hikers will host a winter trip to <u>Blacksmith Fork</u> on Saturday. This is an easy snowshoe (or boot?) activity, about 5 miles round trip and 300 feet of elevation.
