


CACHE HIKERS



2026 Winter Outings

1 January, 2026, Snowshoe/hike in Blacksmith Fork The Cache Hikers will host a winter trip on the [Blacksmith Fork River Trail](#) on **Thursday** (New Year's Day). This is an easy snowshoe or "boot" activity (trail crampons are advised if conditions are icy). Expect about 5 miles round trip and 300 feet of elevation as we follow the south side of Blacksmith Fork River. Bring food, water, and extra clothing. Make sure your equipment is adequate and that you have the skill and stamina necessary for the trip. The trip leader may alter plans if necessary.

Meet at 10:00 a.m. at the southwest corner of the Smith's Marketplace parking lot at 750 North Main Street, with an expected return about 2:00 p.m.

4 January, 2026, Ski/Snowshoe at Stump Hollow The Cache Hikers will host a winter trip at [Stump Hollow](#) on Sunday. This is a moderate snowshoe or cross-country ski event, about 4 miles round trip with 600 feet of elevation. Bring food, water, and extra clothing. Make sure your equipment is adequate and that you have the skill and stamina necessary for the trip. The trip leader may alter plans if necessary.
